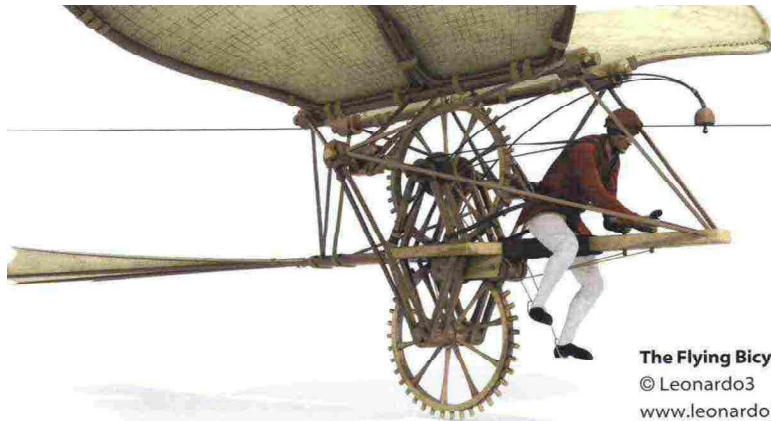
9 NARRATIVE FRAMES

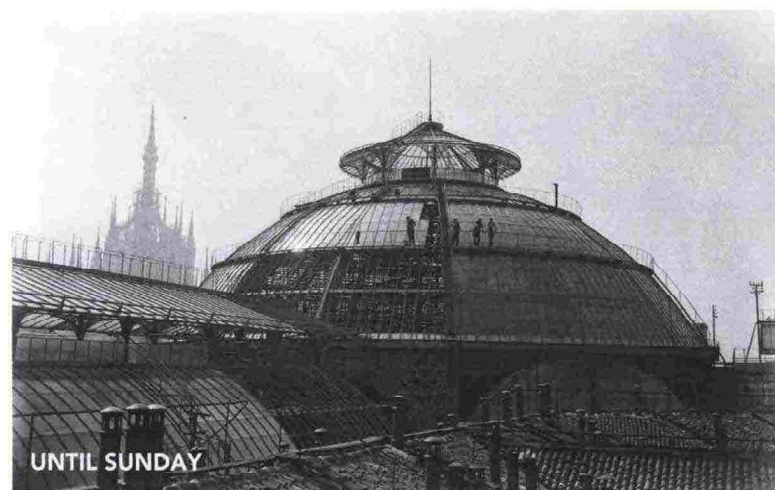
